Review of Australia's General Teriff Arrangements

Classification: Restricted

Submission to the Productivity Commission

In January 1999 we approached the Australian Customs Service and the Department of Industry Science and Resources, over what appeared to be an anomaly in tariff item 8520. In July 1999 we were advised the most appropriate course of action would be to await the forth coming Productivity Commission, and put forward our views.

Tariff Item 8520 reads:- "Magnetic Tape recorders and other sound recording apparatus, whether or not incorporating a sound reproducing device"

We currently import machines that are "Portable Dictating Machines that operate on a digital basis, recording and reproducing information from digital discs or cards".

Tariff Item 8520, has specific sub headings covering portable dictating machines:-

8520,32,10

Digital Dictating Machines (using magnetic tape as the recording medium)

8520.33.10

Other cassette type Dictating Machines.

Both of the sub headings mentioned above have a duty rate of FREE.

As the latest technology does not use cassette tape for recording/reproducing, the digital machines we are importing do no fall within the requirements of sub items 8520.32.10 or 8520.33.10, and therefore are placed in the balance item to 8520, which is 8520,90.00. This item is dutiable at 5% ad valorem, and it would seem that the new technology in this particular area is being penalised, against the old technology of cassette tape.

We would suggest a new sub item be raised to cover: " portable digital dictating machines".

We also request a review of the 3 % revenue duty placed on business input tariff concessions. Most of these concessions cover parts that are imported for the repair of current equipment, for which there is no local manufacture. This brings up the anomaly of importing a complete product duty free, but having to pay duty on parts to repair that machine.




