# PUBLIC HOUSING AND STATE OWNED AND MANAGED INDIGENOUS HOUSING (CHAPTER 16)

- This chapter reports on the performance of governments in providing Commonwealth State
  Housing Agreement (CSHA) public and community housing, and State owned and managed
  Indigenous housing (SOMIH). It also includes Indigenous community housing and the
  delivery of Commonwealth Rent Assistance (CRA). This Fact Sheet focuses on the
  performance of jurisdictions providing public housing and SOMIH.
- There were approximately 340 000 public housing dwellings (table 16A.1) and 13 000 SOMIH dwellings (p. 16.12) in Australia at 30 June 2007.


#### Objectives of public housing and SOMIH


- The aim of the CSHA is to provide appropriate, affordable and secure housing assistance for those who most need it, for the duration of their need (p. 16.2).
- A national ten year strategy to improve Indigenous housing, *Building a Better Future*, was agreed in 2001 by Australian, State and Territory ministers. The desired strategy outcomes are better housing and housing services, more housing, improved partnerships, greater effectiveness and efficiency, and improved performance linked to accountability and coordination of services (p. 16.2).

Public housing — occupancy rates (per cent)<sup>a</sup> (p. 16.37)


SOMIH — occupancy rates<sup>a</sup> (p. 16.38)
