INDIGENOUS COMMUNITY HOUSING (CHAPTER 16)

- This chapter reports on the performance of governments in providing Commonwealth State Housing Agreement (CSHA) public and community housing, State owned and managed Indigenous housing (SOMIH), Indigenous community housing and on the delivery of Commonwealth Rent Assistance (CRA). This Fact Sheet focuses on the delivery and performance of Indigenous community housing.
- There were 21 505 permanent dwellings managed by funded/actively registered and unfunded Indigenous community housing organisations (ICHOs), at 30 June 2006 of which 17 089 managed by funded/actively registered ICHOs (16A.37).


Objectives of Indigenous community housing


• A national ten year strategy to improve Indigenous housing, *Building a Better Future*, was agreed in 2001 by Australian, State and Territory ministers. The desired strategy outcomes are better housing and housing services, more housing, improved partnerships, greater effectiveness and efficiency, and improved performance linked to accountability and coordination of services (p. 16.2).

Indigenous community housing — dwelling condition, 2006^a (p. 16.65)


Indigenous community housing — rent collection rate (per cent)^a (p. 16.67)
